### **GUIDELINES FOR BEHAVIOUR FOR MALE STAFF ON EDUCATIONAL VISITS**

The normal guidelines which apply to situations in School where the member of staff is in loco parentis apply but the specific guidance given below should also be followed:

#### **1. Overnight Camp**

Help with setting up camp, cooking etc. can be freely given but after lights out the male member of staff is present as back up support only. In the first instance all situations should be dealt with by a female member of staff unless help is requested.

#### **2. Manning Checkpoints**

Care must be taken to ensure that the male member of staff is not alone with a student. Should this situation arise, contact must be made with the nearest supervisor and assistance requested.

#### **3. Smoking**

Smoking is not allowed on any School expeditions. Students are expected to uphold these guidelines. Staff are not expected to smoke in front of, or in the vicinity of pupils.

#### **4. First Aid**

First Aid will be administered by qualified First Aiders only.

#### **5. Counselling Students**

Pupils in distress would normally be helped by a female member of staff. If this help is unavailable the male member of staff must be sure that he does not come into contact with the student but talks through the crisis calmly without any physical contact.
